## Admissions process for applicants in the Czech Republic or in countries nearby

- 1. Send the on-line application form
  - Students who do not need a visa are welcome to send the application form any time before the end of August.
  - Students who need a visa must send the application form before the end of June!
- 2. Pay the admission fee 500 Czech Crowns or the equivalent (bank information can be found on your on-line application form)
- 3. Send a scan of the English test results certificate (TOEFL, IELTS, FCE, CAE) or arrange a date for the English admission test
  - Minimum test scores are as follows:
    - IELTS 6 or higher (all parts)
    - TOEFL iBT 65 or higher
    - TOEFL cBT 183 or higher
    - FCE grade B or higher
    - CAE Pass
- 4. Pay the **tuition fee** for one semester 39,500 Czech crowns (approximately **EUR 1,600/semester**, depending on the actual exchange rate)
- 5. Once all administrative documents and payments mentioned are received and approved by IHM, a confirmation of admission to study will be issued and given to you (this document is required to obtain the study visa)
- 6. Please come to the Czech Republic at least one month before classes officially begin!
- 7. IHM will review all the original documents during registration.
- 8. Czech and Slovak students are requested to submit a certified copy of their secondary school diploma in order to close the study contract.
- 9. Students from other countries are requested to submit the official validation of their secondary school diploma before the end of 1<sup>st</sup> semester at the latest. This process could last more than one month and IHM cannot fully accept a student for study without this document!
